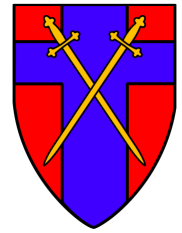

**BFG TEAM FÄLTTÄVLAN (ORIENTEERING AND SHOOTING) CHAMPIONSHIPS AND
BFG LEAGUE ORIENTEERING – GRIMKE AND ALMA 6 RANGE WED 10 NOV 10**

1. **General.** The BFG Team Fälttävlan (orienteering and shooting) Championships will take place on Inkerman Training Area (new Grimke map) and Alma 6 Range on Wed 10 Nov 10 in conjunction with a BFG Orienteering League event. The courses will be prepared in such a way that competitors in the Fälttävlan Championships will have the orienteering element of the event counting towards the appropriate course run on the BFG League event. A separate flier will be prepared for the BFG Orienteering League event where there will be the normal 3 courses.

2. **Entries.** Units may enter one 3 person team in the event with a further 3 person team nominated as a reserve if shooting facilities (only 12 lanes available) permit.

3. **Timings for Wed 10 Nov 10.**

4. **Courses.** The orienteering element will be made up of 3 legs (Two Long A Courses and one Medium B Course). Teams will be informed of the order that they will run the legs at Registration. Personnel are advised to check control codes carefully prior to punching with EMIT. The approximate leg lengths are as follows:

- a. Long A (tech and phys diff) 6.0 - 7.0 km.
- b. Medium (tech and phys mod – diff) 4.5 – 5.5 km.

5. **Entry Form, Fees and Prizes.** The cost to enter the event as a 3 person Fälttävlan team is €25. Cheques are to be made payable to Central Bank 2 LSR and should accompany the Entry Form at Annex A. The Entry Form is to be with the undersigned by COP Fri 22 Oct 10. A team

trophy will be awarded to the 1st Fälttävlan Team with individual prizes for the three team members. Fälttävlan individual prizes will also be awarded to the three team members of the Runners Up team. Prize Giving will be held at approximately 1530.

6. **Map and Terrain.** The Inkerman and Southern Fields maps have been extended to the North to incorporate the area of Grimke and the Alma 5 and 6 Ranges. The map is at a scale of 1:10,000 with 5m contours and was completed in Aug 10. The maps will be overprinted with courses on waterproof paper with control descriptions. Control descriptions **will not** be issued separately. The terrain is typical of Sennelager Training Area with some open areas and detailed contours in the Inkerman area.

7. **Format of the Competition.** Prior to the start, all weapons will be cleared, loaded (not made ready) and laid out in team order. The first leg runners will have a mass start from behind the 400m Firing Point and will commence with orienteering. On their return to the range, they will follow a marked route via the left side of the Alma 6 Firing Points, collect their weapon and magazine and continue to the allocated Firing Lane on the 300m Firing Point. They will then adopt the prone unsupported position, load, make ready and fire 5 rounds at a Fig 12 target which will appear at a distance of 200m and 'fall when hit'. Once all 5 rounds have been fired, the weapon will be unloaded, cleared and laid down on the Firing Point where it will be cleared again by a member of the Safety Staff. The orienteer is then to follow the taped route to the end of the 300m Firing Point (right side) where he/she will find out if they have Penalty Loops. They then run up the right side of the Range to the 400m point. There will be one penalty loop for each shot that misses the target. A penalty loop is approximately 200m. Once the orienteer has completed Penalty Loops, he/she runs to the handover area and then in to the finish funnel. The second orienteer then commences orienteering followed by shooting. On their return, they complete the shooting and handover to the third leg runner. Once the third leg runner completes the orienteering, shooting and any penalty loops, he/she runs to the finish. The winning team will be the first team to complete all three orienteering legs successfully and without errors in the fastest time after completing any Penalty Loops. A penalty of 15 minutes will be added for each control missed.

8. **Dress.** The dress for both the orienteering and shooting is to be normal orienteering type clothing. **At least one set of muff type ear defenders must be provided on the Firing Point by each team.**

9. **Weapons.** In order to make the shooting element of the competition fair for all participants, the SA 80 Individual Weapon is to be used with SUSAT. Teams should bring 3 weapons per team, with at least one magazine for each weapon. The weapons will be cleared, marked and laid out in team order prior to the start of the competition. **Personnel are not required to complete the orienteering stage with the weapon.**

10. **Ammunition.** QM 1 ADSR will be requested to provide the ammunition for the competition (360 rds 5.56mm Ball). He will also be requested to provide the ammunition for the confirmatory zero (quantity of 5.56mm Ball tbc). The OIC Range will demand for the ammunition and arrange for the collection and return.

11. **Safety.** Team Captains are to complete the Weapon Handling Test Certificate at Annex B and hand it in at Registration. All personnel will receive a detailed briefing on the format of the competition and safety rules at 1115. The wearing of ear defenders during the shooting phase is compulsory for all personnel. White Mine Tape will be placed across the Grimke area and behind Alma Ranges 5 and 6 to ensure that personnel enter the range safely from the final Control. Signs will be provided on the Alma Range Road warning drivers of orienteers crossing the road; the Crossing Point will be manned. **Each team entering the Championships is to bring one qualified Safety Supervisor in addition to their Fälttävlan team.**

12. **Refreshments.** Refreshments will be provided at the Admin Area.
