## “GOLDGRUND” PADERBORN

Date: Wed 13 Oct 10

Location: Goldgrund Training Area (Areas 1, 2 and 3).  
Take B64 to the K29 exit, East of Paderborn.  
Signposted from GR 8732 2939. Parking on road before Trg Area main entry at GR 874 292.

Terrain: Typical North Germany Training Area. Rolling hills with open land criss-crossed with vehicle tracks. Woods are mainly runnable with numerous tracks. Many small knolls, depressions and craters.

Map: Scale: 1:10,000 **5m Contours** 5 Colour  
Drawn September 2010 by Tony Farrow/ Gareth Bramwell.  
Some inaccuracies can be expected as this is a new map and areas not being used have not been fully mapped.

Courses: Depending on final controlling:

A Course	8.9 km	Technically moderate – difficult
B Course	4.4 km	Technically moderate
C Course	3.3 km	Technically easy – moderate

Starts 1115 – 1515  
Courses Close 1600 (controls collected)  
Please do not arrive too early as this is also 3 CS Bn REME's CO's Cup Competition.
